### The Facts

- One-week classes for children from ages 4-5, 6-7 and 8 & up
  - Located at St. Michael Catholic Secondary School, 240 Oakdale Ave, Stratford (fully air-conditioned)
  - Experienced adult instructors who are practicing artists/educators
  - Original content and art activities
  - Supervised time outdoors during lunch break, plus two snack/play breaks
  - Small classes – maximum of 15 students with an instructor and assistant
  - A safe, creative & rewarding atmosphere for your child
  - Registration on a first-come, first-served basis
  - Classes run from 9am to Noon & 1-4pm for ½ day programs, or 9am-4pm for full day programs
- Primary students (ages 4-5) may only register for ½ days, unless the child is used to attending full-day school
  - To register, child must have reached the minimum age requirement by December 31, 2009
  - To place your child in the same class as another student in the same age group, please indicate this on both registration forms
  - Registrants for the French Camp must be members of CPF – Stratford Chapter

**Young Artists** –This program is designed for our youngest artists combining play with hands on creative art projects. Children will experiment in many mediums including, painting, drawing and collage.

**Under The Sea-** Come and explore this exciting, colourful and vast world through art making. Many techniques and mediums will be explored during the week including drawing, painting and 3 Dimensional art.

**World cultures** -Travel through Ancient civilizations including the Maya and Incas civilizations by creatively drawing, painting and exploring art making techniques linked to these fascinating civilizations.

**Myths and Legends-** Myths and Legends will envelope the artist in a world filled with fun and creative art making. Animal and hero myths will be some of the themes for the young artist to explore through drawing, painting, sculpture in a creative and fun atmosphere. Bring your favorite myth or legend to class.

**Story Book Illustration** -This fun and creative class explores the ways to illustrate for a story. Draw, draw and draw. Write your own story or create a character from your imagination. Learn the tricks of the trade by professional illustrator, Todd Mulligan.

**Painterly Styles** - Have you ever wanted to try to paint like Monet, Kandinsky, Picasso and Pollock? Come and learn the various techniques in these painterly styles. Explore pointillism, abstraction, realism, and surrealism. Come prepared to paint, draw and have fun!

**Get Ready..Sketch, Draw and Colour** - Learn how to draw the human figure, animals, landscapes and everything in between. This week of intensive drawing explores pencil, pen and ink, pastels and other mixed mediums in a fun and creative atmosphere.

**Art Fantastique** - This fun filled week en Francais explores drawing, painting, 3D art in a group environment which encourages lots of conversation and creativity.
