Based on movement, this workshop explores how quick movement can change perspectives and how the eye reacts. Students create their own Thaumatrope and have the chance to experiment with their uniqueness. (A, ST)



Students will analyze various cityscapes to be inspired to create their own using 2 & 3D shapes. Shape and form and space will guide student's decision-making process as they use printmaking and mixed media to create their personalized cityscape. (A, M, ST, SS)



Exploring the fundamental concept of colour, students will work with watercolour paints as they engage in the exploration of primary and secondary colours creating a piece of art with warm, cool & complementary colours. (A)



Using acrylic paints students will explore the colour wheel as they create their own complementary colour pallets. With these, Indigenous Artists will inspire students as they create a unique piece without using a paintbrush! (A, SS)



As students explore the Gallery they will be challenged to use the critical analysis process to create their point of view on the exhibitions and be inspired to create their own masterpiece as it reflects the works of local artists. Contact for current and upcoming exhibitions. (A, M, ST, SS)
