Ages 4-6

Budding Artists: Budding Artists will use a wide range of playful artist materials while capturing their natural creativity. From painting and drawing to mixed-media and sculpture – Budding Artists will nourish self-expression, further develop motor skills, and create striking works of art.

Ages 6-12

Character Illustration: Dust off your Sharpies – it's that time of year when everyone's favourite illustrator, Todd Mulligan, inspires us to draw characters, animals, landscapes and everything in between. If you like to draw, sketch or doodle, you'll love Character Illustration.

Art Inspirations: Travel through time by learning about important periods in art, and then creating work inspired by these periods. Each day will focus on a different art movement and the art that came out of these movements. Create a cubism sculpture that would make Picasso proud, or floating chalk art inspired by the impressionism of Monet. We will explore a variety of techniques and mediums this week!

Artsy Einstein's: Science and art have a lot more in common than you might think: don't believe us? We'll show you! Learn how to make your own Play-Doh and paint, and multiple other projects that will bring together the world of science and art!

Painting Exploration: There are so many ways to apply paint to a surface. Explore the world of painting through colour, style, texture, and painting mediums such as watercolour, tempera and acrylic. Be prepared to get creative and try out different techniques for applying paint to both conventional and unconventional surfaces.

Art Around the World: Each day, you will explore a different country and create art inspired by all the places you visit. Travelers will create their own passport and receive a new stamp every time we visit somewhere new. We may find ourselves in Egypt, building a clay pyramid or a pharaoh's tomb, or in Holland, creating our own Dutch windmills and tulip gardens.

Art in the Grove: Let's take advantage of the gorgeous summer weather and create art using the best canvas of all- the great outdoors! Using a mixture of materials found in nature, as well as our own supplies, we will create a variety of fun, exciting projects. Walks through the Old Grove and surrounding area will serve as inspiration for our artwork.

Art in the Wild: Create art inspired by the wilderness and your favourite animals. Explore mediums, such as drawing, painting, mixed media and sculpture to create artwork that is full of life and inspired by wild animals, plants, and wild places from around the world.

The World of Art and the Art of Words: Explore how the world of art and the art of words can work together to create new and exciting things. We will be working on a variety of word-based art including (but certainly not limited to) cork art created using your initials, acrylic paintings inspired by other students' writing, and collaborative comic book strips.

Ages 10-14

Film Camp: In this hands-on film production program, we will explore different cinematic genres creating our own film sequence inspired by various styles, directors and ideas. Learn how to story-board and shoot collaborative ideas while trying your hand at writing, directing, production design, cinematography, sound, lighting and even acting!

Inbetweens Studio:

Inbetweens Studio is a place where creative, like-minds meet to make really, really cool art. Be inspired to tackle new projects every day and enjoy the freedom to express your artistic nature. Explorations include painting, drawing, mixed media, and sculpture.

Steelbox Art Lab:

Here is a chance to collaborate with others and create your own art exhibition from beginning to end. Participants will have a week to plan, create artwork, install, write about, and promote their own exhibition is Gallery Stratford's Steelbox Art Lab, located in the YMCA parking lot. Campers will split their time between Avon Public School and our Steelbox downtown to create an exhibition that will remain up over the weekend following the camp week.

Printmaking: Explore the magic of printmaking. Create innovative prints using a variety of techniques and processes, including relief printing, monoprints and stamping. Experiment with textures and patterns while exploring negative and positive space, colour and more, in this course taught by Artist Miranda Franken. Please note there will be use of some sharp utensils.
